Summary of Findings

Brandon Tyler Gray is a 27-year-old, self-described gay man who lives in Oak Ridge, NC. Gray describes himself as a graduate of a political science program at Guilford Technical Community College; however, from 2019 through early 2022, Gray was unemployed. Earlier this year, he established a company focused on social networking and digital contact out of his home. As a candidate in 2020, Gray was unmarried and lived alone with his grandmother, but his husband, Charles Michael Holbrook, age 24, now resides with them.

According to a financial disclosure filed with the North Carolina Ethics Commission, not only is Gray unemployed, but he does not own property, owe anyone money, nor did he receive income or have assets in 2019. His grandmother is employed as a bookkeeper for a painting and wallpaper company called MEP, and his husband works as a traveling nurse. Incidentally, the home where they live is owned by Mepfigozep Franco Grajeda, the owner of MEP Painting and Wallpaper.

It appears that Gray likely faced trauma as a child. According to court documents, his name was changed from Brandon Tyler Hardy to Brandon Tyler Gray at age five. At age eight, he was adopted by Brian Scott Gray, but less than three years later, the adoption decree was overturned amidst his mom and adoptive dad's divorce. Because adoption records are not released without court order to anyone other than the parties involved, we do not have additional information about this time in his life, although his adoptive father continued visitation with his biological daughter, Gray's half-sister. It appears that Mary Daniel Cross is his biological grandmother, as some of the names the filing when he was five match hers (Cross). Outside of the name change and the adoption records, Gray was named as the defendant in a speeding ticket in Wayne County. He pled to a lesser charge of improper equipment.

In 1990, years prior to Gray's birth, Mary Daniel Cross was indicted and convicted for corporate malfeasance. Between 1985 and 1989, while working at the *Greensboro News & Record*, she wrote cashed bad checks and covered up the bank notifications and numbers in her bookkeeping. Her conviction involved a 15-year suspended prison sentence, 88 "weekends" (adjusted to Tuesdays and Wednesdays to keep her waitressing jobs), and \$30,000 in restitution. It appears that she had her rights restored at some point, as she re-registered to vote in 2004. She voted in 2010 and 2012 Republican primaries. This same ex-felon (for Corporate Malfeasance) is now the registered Treasurer of Brandon Gray's campaign account.

Charles Holbrook, who goes by Michael, was the subject of traffic cases over the past seven years, but the biggest complaint against him involved a citation for assault stemming from a 2020 incident at the Walmart in Greensboro. Immediately after the confrontation, Gray took to social media alleging that he and his boyfriend were assaulted with homophobic slurs. He claimed a hate crime, and news coverage indicated that Rebecca McCabe was charged with assault, too. In the assault complaint against Michael, McCabe said her daughter and cousin were trying on bathing suits over their clothing, as the fitting rooms were closed due to COVID, and the girls were uncomfortable

because Gray and his boyfriend walked past them more than once. After she asked them to leave the area, McCabe alleges that Michael called her a name before she called them “Queer Motherfuckers.” Upon repeating the slur, Michael shoved McCabe into a display, injuring her. In court, however, her witness failed to testify and the matter was dropped.

After losing the 2020 race by nearly 15 points, Gray is running again in what he describes as a “bluer” seat. He raised less than \$20,000 during the 2020 cycle, and his grandmother, as Treasurer, failed to file timely reports for the committee after the election and the next few reports, costing him \$550 (and a waiver of \$500). Like 2020, he was unopposed in the May Primary in 2022.

Gray’s contributions to others are limited to \$155 to his own committee in North Carolina and \$11 split between Elizabeth Warren’s, Amy Klobuchar’s, and Kristen Gillibrand’s 2020 presidential campaigns.

I have been active in Politics since 2015. Being a 25 year old I bring a different perspective to the table. What we have now isn't working. We need someone who will actually work for their constituents, not special interest groups. I have been standing up to bullies my whole life, and now I'm ready to stand up to the ones in Raleigh. I am a fighter. I am fighting for progress, and for the people within my district. I was raised to always give back no matter how little we had, and to help in anyway I could. So, I am running for North Carolina House because that is how I believe I can best help our community. I am running because I know what is at stake in November. I am running for our future. We need to have a leader who is fighting for the people, and fighting for progress. No more fighting for special interest groups.

Let's do this!

In 2022, an updated version of the biography left out Gray's sexual orientation (and husband) and indicates he is now a small business owner.

Holbrook holds a permanent RN license (ID: 320864) with a multi-state compact agreement. Initially approved on January 27, 2020, his license will expire on June 30, 2023.

Legal and Financial Records

Statement of Economic Interest

Gray submitted a statement of economic interest to the North Carolina Ethics Commission on January 20, 2020 and as a candidate for House in 2022.

Employer/Occupation

In 2020, Gray was unemployed according to his financial disclosure. By 2022, he lists that he is a self-employed businessman.

Family Members

In 2020, Gray lived alone with his grandmother, Mary Daniel Cross, who works as a bookkeeper for MEP Painting and Wallpapering. In 2022, in addition to his grandmother, Gray also lives with his husband, Charles Michael Holbrook, a registered nurse who works on contracts and travels.

Property Ownership

Nothing in this section was disclosed in 2020, although in 2022, Gray listed that his grandmother, Mary Daniel Cross, is the owner of a parcel in Summerfield and not the home where they reside.

Debts Exceeding \$10,000

Charles Michael Holbrook has student loans.

Income Sources

Like in 2020, Gray disclosed no income from any source exceeding \$5,000 from any source. In 2022, though, he disclosed his grandmother's income as a bookkeeper for MEP Paintings and Wallcoverings and his husband's work as a traveling nurse.

It should be noted that Gray did not disclose the name of any businesses that he owns.

Property Records

Gray does not own any property in North Carolina. The home where he resides with his grandmother is owned by Mepfigozep Franco Grajeda, the owner of MEP Painting and Wallpaper. The 1,140 square foot home on 0.94 acres. Zillow lists a current value of \$179,400.

Legal Filings

Traffic Case

In August 2013, Gray was cited for speeding and pled to a lesser charge.

Adoption Records and Name Change

Gray was born Brandon Tyler Hardy, but his name was changed to Brandon Tyler Gray on November 21, 2000, when he was five years old. Other names in the filings include Teo Everette Hardy and Tamera Lynn Cross. Because of the age of the case, all records except the summary page were destroyed.

He was adopted formally by Brian Scott Gray on September 8, 2003, at age eight. Fewer than three years later, on March 17, 2006, the court approved an order setting aside the adoption decree, an issue which came up during his mother and adoptive father's divorce. A consent order in the divorce filing was amended on March 20, 2006 to "*...omit any reference to Brandon Tyler Hardy (formerly known as Brandon Tyler Gray), and Brian Scott Gray shall have no right, responsibility or legal duty or obligation regarding him by virtue or prior orders.*"

Brandon's biological half-sister, Jessica, who is the daughter of Brian Gray, continued to have contact and visitation with her father.

In 2020, Holbrook was charged with assaulting a female (case no. 20CR081162). The incident leading to the charge, which was discussed in the media, differs from the complaint and charge in court.

Brandon Gray is running for House District 62, he says, because he is tired of watching politicians stand idle while the world’s problems go unsolved, unaddressed. “I’m running because I’m mad,” Gray, a Democrat, wrote in the statement announcing his campaign last October. He was going to take the fight directly to the General Assembly where politicians, he said, were too timid to get directly involved in their communities’ struggles.

Gray, who describes himself on his website as “an unbought, unbossed, openly-gay man running in a red district breaking all the rules and barriers,” got a first-hand experience this month in what it means to directly confront those particular barriers. According to Gray, on July 9 he and his boyfriend, Michael Holbrook, were assaulted at a Walmart in Greensboro by a woman who hurled homophobic slurs at them. The encounter, he said in an interview with *Cardinal & Pine*, showed the need for increased protections for LGBTQ people in North Carolina.

In social media posts after the encounter and later in the interview, Gray said he was shopping for his grandmother, who is high-risk for COVID, and who needed new tank tops in the summer heat.

The couple entered the women’s section where they saw the woman and her daughter in an aisle. The daughter was changing, trying on a dress in the open because the dressing rooms were closed under the store’s pandemic protocols. Gray alleges that the woman saw them and immediately started berating them, using homophobic slurs. The conflict escalated, and she put her hands around Holbrooks’ throat, according to Gray.

The woman eventually fled the store, and Gray later pressed charges against her. She was identified by court and law enforcement officials as Rebecca McCabe, 34. A Greensboro Police Department spokesman and an employee at the Guilford County Courthouse confirmed that McCabe had been charged with simple assault in the case.

No attorney was listed, the county clerk said, and it is unclear if McCabe has representation. Messages left on a number linked to McCabe through public records were not immediately returned.

Gray first posted news of the attack on social media, writing, "It's a shame that in 2020 we're still dealing with homophobic bigots."

Gray's encounter is not atypical. 'If this had happened in any other state it would have been labeled a hate crime.'

Gray described the encounter as a hate crime, which the FBI defines as a crime motivated by a victim's race, color, religion, national origin, and, as of 2009, "actual or perceived sexual orientation."

NC does not keep track of hate crimes against LGBTQ people, however, so the state is missing data vital to painting a clear scope of the problem.

"Currently NC does not report hate crime data based on sexual orientation or gender identity (SOGI) to the FBI," Ames Simmons, policy director of Equality NC, told *Cardinal & Pine*.

Simmons said his organization, which advocates for LGBTQ equality, worked with state Sen. Jay Chaudhuri, a Wake County Democrat, on a bill requiring tracking of such assaults in NC, but the bill did not pass in this year's legislative session.

"If this had happened in any other state it would have been labeled a hate crime," Gray said. "And that's exactly what it was. LGTBQ people should be under the umbrella of hate crimes in NC."

Some local jurisdictions do keep track of that data, Simmons said, but "there isn't consistent tracking or reporting at the local level across the state."

The prevalence of harassment and attacks nationwide, however, are well documented. According to a 2019 FBI report, though hate crimes fell slightly overall in 2018, those targeting LGTBQ people rose by nearly 6%.

"A lot of people have reached out to me," Gray said. "I know this is the reality for a lot of different people. We've seen black people harassed in stores and that is

something they experience every day. I've also had a transgender woman reach out to me, and she said this is her reality when she is shopping for clothes.”

He added: “It’s so much bigger than just me, but it only solidifies the reason why I decided to get in this race and why I’m in this fight.”

Gray said that the hate crime designation was only one of the more important issues affecting LGBTQ people. Protections were still needed both in the state and nationally, he said, and if elected to the district seat he would prioritize:

- Youth homelessness. It has an outsized effect on LGBTQ people, he said, because youth are often kicked out of the house after coming out to their parents.
- Workplace discrimination. It remains a big concern, even after the Supreme Court decision this month prohibiting employer discrimination over sexual preference or gender identity.
- Prohibitions on sexually active gay people giving blood. “People are dying and need blood, I don’t think we should be discriminating against people because of outdated views,” Gray said.

Gray is facing the incumbent John Faircloth in November. Faircloth won the seat in 2018 with 57% of the vote, but District 62 is difficult to predict because it was created during redistricting in 2017.

Victory Institute, “the only national organization dedicated to elevating openly LGBTQ leaders,” issued a comprehensive report this week showing that the number of LGBTQ elected officials in the U.S. was higher than ever. There are 843 openly LGBTQ officials, up 21% from last year.

There are 28 LGBTQ elected officials in NC, including 5 in the General Assembly. Gray said he decided to run for the seat in large part because of Faircloth’s support and vote for HB 2, the bathroom bill widely viewed as discriminatory to transgender people. The legislation spurred a massive controversy, and some blame ex-Gov. Pat McCrory’s loss to Roy Cooper in 2016 on its outsized effect.

“My opponent was one of the biggest cheerleaders of HB 2,” Gray said. “He supported it and also voted for it. As a member of the LGBTQ community it was very hard to see a representative vote that way. “It didn’t sit well with me.”

Faircloth has not responded to phone or email messages seeking comment. Gray said that the assault in Walmart was not indicative of the reception he’s received as he traveled the district.

“A lot of people write this district off because they think it’s more red,” he said. “But we have so many people who are open-minded and who are accepting and loving of all people, and that is what I’ve experienced the last 10 months of my campaign.”

Gray said that he and Holbrook took a break from social media since the assault, but they were both uninjured. Holbrook, an ICU nurse, had some scratches on his neck, but returned to work.

In the court version of events, McCabe indicated that she was helping her daughter and cousin shop for bathing suits. Because of COVID, the dressing rooms were closed and the girls were trying on suits over their clothes, while she attempted to block the view. McCabe claims that Gray and Holcomb walked through more than one, and she asked them to leave the women’s area because the girls were uncomfortable.

McCabe claims that Holbrook called her a “dumb ass bitch,” and in return, she called him a “queer motherfucker.” He demanded that she say it again, and she did. At that time, he put his hand on her chest and shoved her into a rack, and she was injured.

When the matter came to court, the prosecution witness refused to testify, causing the issue to be dismissed. McCabe is a registered as an Independent, but she is not a consistent voter.

Mary Daniel Cross Criminal Records

Prior to Gray’s birth, Cross was given a 15-year suspended sentence after pleading guilty to five counts of embezzlement from *The Greensboro News & Record*, where she worked with as a bookkeeper.

The former accounting services manager for the Greensboro News & Record was given a suspended 15-year prison sentence Thursday and ordered to repay \$30,000 for her part in an embezzlement scheme that cost the newspaper more than \$130,000.

Mary Daniel Cross, 44, took the money between 1985 and May 1989 by cashing bad checks at the newspaper, then doctoring records to hide the losses once the checks were returned by a bank, according to police and prosecutors. She pleaded guilty to five counts of felony malfeasance by a corporate officer.

In addition to the suspended sentence and restitution, Superior Court Judge Russell G. Walker Jr. ordered Cross to spend 88 consecutive weekends in jail starting later this month. The weekly jail times were changed to Tuesday and Wednesday after her lawyer argued that Cross needs her weekends free to juggle two waitressing jobs she holds.

His grandmother, Mary Daniel Cross, who was convicted of corporate malfeasance and works as a professional bookkeeper, serves as his treasurer.

Penalties/Ethics Filings

An audit letter dated July 21, 2020 showed some minor issues with reporting and dates, and indicated they needed to use “best efforts” to identify employers and occupations of contributors, but Gray was not cited for any violations in the filing.

On September 13, 2021, the North Carolina State Board of Elections fined Gray, via his grandmother/treasurer, \$550 for late filings of his 2020 first quarter and 2020 fourth quarter reports. Because he was a first-time candidate and filer, they waived \$500 of the total penalty. He paid a \$50 assessment on October 7, 2021 via a cashier’s check.

On October 15, 2021, Gray was again notified and assessed a \$500 penalty for non-filing of his mid-year, 2021 report. He paid the penalty on November 11, 2021, via cashier’s check.

Election Results

2020 Elections

After running unopposed in the primary in 2020, Gray was easily defeated by his Republican opponent, John Faircloth, in the general election.
