## Summary of Findings

Linda Cooper-Suggs is a 69-year-old retired schoolteacher and Democrat living in Wilson, North Carolina. In late July 2020, she was appointed by the local Democratic party to replace Jean Farmer Butterfield in the North Carolina House, who accepted a political appointment by Governor Roy Cooper.

Cooper-Suggs was married in 1986 to Aaron Murdock Suggs, and by 1988, the two had a son and daughter, Aaron Jr. and Paislei. The marriage was relatively short-lived.

Despite the difficulties she faced in her personal life, Cooper-Suggs raised the two children and paid for her home outright. In 2018, State Employees' Credit Union released her final, \$35,000 line of credit on the house. All property taxes on the home since 2002 are current and were paid on time. She made late property taxes on two occasions, in 2000 and 2001, accumulating about \$50 in late fees and interest.

Cooper-Suggs defeated her Republican opponent during the 2020 election by just more than 2,000 votes, following a late start in the campaign season (her appointment just months before the November election). She raised more than \$62,000 during the third quarter of 2020. Currently however, her 2022 contributions are limited to contributions from herself. In addition, her treasurer seems to consistently run afoul of campaign finance laws. To date, her committee was assessed \$550 (plus \$450 that was waived) for filing reports late.

## Biography

In lieu of a formal biography, as Cooper-Suggs recently joined the legislature as a replacement to Representative Jean Farmer-Butterfield, the following article about her selection provides limited biographical data.

**A retired educator and county Democratic Party chairwoman will serve out the term of former North Carolina state Rep. Jean Farmer-Butterfield and seek her own two-year term in the fall.**

**Democratic activists in Wilson County meeting on Saturday selected Linda Cooper-Suggs to fill the vacancy created when Farmer-Butterfield resigned from her 24th House District seat, The Wilson Times reported.**

**Farmer-Butterfield stepped down last week after the legislature confirmed her as Gov. Roy Cooper's nominee to join the North Carolina Employment Security Board of Review. The governor is now obligated by law to formally appoint Cooper-Suggs.**

**Nine candidates were initially seeking the seat. Local party officials ultimately voted from a list of six hopefuls.**

**Cooper-Suggs, the Wilson Democratic Party leader since 2017, also was picked as the candidate to take on Republican Mick Rankin in November. Farmer-Butterfield, a House member since 2003, had already won the Democratic primary in March.**

**"I thank everyone for putting their trust in me and for their vote," Cooper-Suggs said Saturday. "I thank everyone for their hard work. We are in this together."**

**In light of social distancing due to COVID-19, Saturday's meeting was a combination of video conferencing and motorists sitting in their cars in a church parking lot.**

- Cooper Suggs borrowed \$15,900 via a home equity line of credit from State Employees' Credit Union on April 3, 2006.
- Cooper Suggs borrowed \$35,000 via a home equity line of credit on July 29, 2010 from State Employees' Credit Union.
- On August 5, 2010, State Employees' Credit Union released the loan signed by Cooper Suggs on April 3, 2006.
- On May 21, 2018, State Employees' Credit Union released the loan signed by Cooper Suggs on July 29, 2010.

According to Wilson County records (back to 2001), our searches show that Cooper-Suggs made late payments in 2000 and 2001, although taxes were paid on time since that time.

## **Legal Records**

Cooper-Suggs was engaged in family law matters in Wilson County in the early 1990s, in addition to three traffic filings. Three filings that list a Linda Suggs in Wake County are pending retrieval from the archives.

Of note, Cooper-Suggs's ex-husband Aaron is a criminal, and his instability and convictions posed a problem during their divorce proceedings (couldn't appear because of incarceration).

### ***Family Law***

Beginning in 1989, Cooper-Suggs filed suit against Suggs, although the details of the filing were no longer a part of the record. The case was dismissed in December 1990 for lack of prosecution.

- Linda Cooper Suggs and Allen Thomas v. Aaron Suggs (filing no. 89-CVD-982)
  - Filed in Wilson County, NC
  - Dismissed for lack of prosecution on December 20, 1990

In 1991, Cooper-Suggs filed for custody of their children and for sole possession of their Wilson, NC home. Although we do not have the original petition, this was likely a divorce application, as the judge made a preliminary order that she received exclusive possession/use of the marital home (with orders for eviction proceedings), custody of the children, reasonable child support, and Aaron was given six weeks to find an attorney to represent him in the matter.

- Linda Cooper Suggs v. Aaron M. Suggs (case no. 91-CVD-960)
  - Filed in Wilson County, NC
  - Order giving Cooper-Suggs full custody of children and possession of house dated July 25, 1991

A year later, Cooper-Suggs was finally granted a divorce.

- Linda Cooper Suggs v. Aaron M. Suggs (case no. 92-CVD-1280)
  - Filed in Wilson County, NC
  - Judgment dated September 24, 1992 – granting Cooper-Suggs entire home (without equity division), full custody of the children, and a divorce

A 1993 case likely dealt with child support – Wilson County OBO, Linda Cooper Suggs, and the State of North Carolina v. Aaron Suggs (case no. 93-CVD-001270).

Cooper-Suggs pled down two speeding tickets in 2014 and 2020 to lesser penalties.

## Political Activities

### Campaign Finance

Cooper-Suggs established a campaign finance committee, Linda Cooper Suggs for NC (ID: STA-6QD149-C-001), with the North Carolina State Board of Elections on July 31, 2020. In an organizational committee report covering the end of July, Cooper-Suggs disclosed one contribution totaling \$200 from herself.

### *Contributions by Industry*

Based on her contributions, Cooper-Suggs received nearly \$22,000 from Democratic candidates and committees, followed by more than \$10,500 from people who are not employed. All itemized contributions received earlier this year came directly from Cooper-Suggs.

### **Correspondence from the North Carolina State Board of Elections**

On September 8, 2021, the North Carolina State Board of Elections sent a penalty assessment letter to Conen Morgan, as Treasurer for Linda Cooper Suggs for NC. In it, they alleged that the 2020 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Report was submitted nine days late (\$50 per day times nine days = \$450) and her 2020 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Report was filed one day late (\$50 per day times one day = \$50). The \$500 penalty assessed was reduced by \$450 for a total of \$50 due by October 8, 2021.

The committee remitted payment totaling \$50 on September 20, 2021.

Again, on December 3, 2021, the Cooper-Suggs committee was fined \$500 for the (10-day) late filing of a 2021 mid-year semi-annual report. The \$500 penalty was paid on December 9, 2021.

On February 3, 2022, the State Board of Elections notified Cooper-Suggs that the software they were using was not calibrated to reflect the proper date, causing reports to show the wrong year/not filed.

### **Election Results**

Cooper-Suggs was unopposed during the primary election in 2020. Her election in 2020 shows she received just 2000 more votes than Republican Mick Rankin.

#### ***2020 General Election***

Cooper-Suggs defeated her Republican opponent by just 5 points during the 2020 general election.
