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Summary of Findings

Terry Garrison is a three-term Democrat representing Vance County and the 32nd District in the North Carolina House. A Real Estate Broker by trade, Garrison also spent years working in technical school and adult education in North Carolina for decades.

Prior to serving in the North Carolina House, Garrison also served on the Vance County Commission for years, an organization from which he purchased a home in 2012, and his properties number in the dozens. Garrison, as a landlord, was named in at least three lawsuits by tenants. While none were successful, all three were filed by impoverished people, and two alleged faulty electrical wiring led to fires while they were residents in his home.

Garrison has no family. He was married in 1989, but his ex-wife accused him of hitting her in 1994, a matter that was dropped by the DA. In March 1996, the two separated and were divorced by mid-1996. In records dating back to the early 1980s, Garrison was cited on nine occasions for traffic infractions, including a conviction for reckless driving to endanger in 1983. Garrison is also a deacon at Shiloh Baptist Church, and in that role, the church was sued multiple times for excluding members who didn't fit a certain "Christian" ideal. While we only have copies of one of these suits, we are informed of others existing.

As a candidate, Garrison reported just more than \$8,700 cash on hand at the end of April 2022. Over the years, he reported raising more than \$45,000 from government employees and educators. He was the largest contributor to his own campaign, giving himself more than \$41,000.

To other candidates and committees, Garrison gave just more than \$5,000 to federal candidates and committees in mostly small-dollar amounts through ActBlue. In North Carolina, his contributions totaled more than \$20,000, besides the \$41,000 he gave to himself, during that past decade.

After earning more than two-thirds of the vote during the primary in 2016, Garrison ran unopposed in the 2016 General Election. He faced Republican opponents in both 2018 and 2020, although neither failed to secure more than 39% of the vote.

Family Law

Deloris Lucille Jerman Garrison petitioned for divorce from Garrison in 1998. Because the two separated more than a year prior, on March 30, 1996, the filing was finalized by August 11, 1998. According to the filing, the two were married on July 21, 1989 and had no children. At the signing of the divorce decree, Deloris resumed use of her maiden name.

Civil Filings

As a landlord, Garrison was named in several civil filings as a defendant, raising questions of whether he is a slumlord. According to these filings, he had at least two house fires in rental homes in fewer than twenty years. Of note, these are single females filing suit against Garrison, indicative that either he did not lease properties to men, or they possibly did not receive equal treatment by him during their tenancy.

Boyd filed documentation in this case indicating she was indigent at the time of the case, but alleged she was owed \$825 in property damage from a fire caused by a defective electrical system in the home she rented from Garrison. The case was dismissed on May 28, 1991. She unsuccessfully appealed the decision in 1998.

Dodson alleged that Garrison owed her \$4,800 for an illegal eviction, destruction of a vehicle, and personal reimbursement of her deposit. The court found that she did not prove her case.

Johnson claimed \$2,000 in damages because her clothing, shoes, and personal effects were burned/smoked in a house fire on February 22, 2009, caused by an electrical fault. The courts alleged that the plaintiff did not prove Garrison responsible, and she did not recover anything.

As the Deacon of Shiloh Baptist Church, Garrison was named in several suits relating to the exclusion of certain members, especially single females, or those deemed by the church to be living “less than” a Christian lifestyle. Some of these suits were not included in our request for document; however, we have copies of at least one.

- Loree Drake Vaughan, Ronald Vaughan, and Lafayette Messenburg v. Joseph Ratliff, Pastor of Shiloh Baptist Church and the Board of Deacons (case no. 00CVS-498)

Loree alleged that disparaging remarks about her were made by Pastor Ratliff indicating that she “did not exemplify the qualities of a Christian lady”, that Ronald “sowed discontent”, and that Lafayette had not contributed to the church in many years. Thusly, the three were “Judases.” The suit claimed a loss of reputation and claimed \$10,000 in damages.

The suit was resolved in mediation and voluntarily dismissed on February 5, 2001. While Garrison is not indicated by name in the filing, he served as a deacon at the time. He made no filings in the suit, neither distancing nor disputing the charges.

Political Activities

Campaign Finance

Garrison should not be considered a prolific fundraiser, but records show that he also has not faces difficult competition in his bid for North Carolina House during the past six years. As of April 30, 2022, he had just \$7,800 cash on hand headed into the 2022 race.

2016 District 32 Primary Election

Garrison defeated Gary Lamont Miles Sr. in a primary election in March 2016 for House District 32. He earned more than two-thirds of the vote.
