## Summary of Findings

Sherrie Mae Young is a 31-year-old mother of two who lives in Greensboro, NC. With claims of a career in nursing but no license reported in North Carolina or Virginia, it is unclear what she does for a living. Even more surprising was her May 2022 upset victory (with more than 74% of the vote) against a better funded and much more qualified opponent.

Young has a very troubled past, as have the men with whom she spends her time. She is currently facing trial for allegedly chasing someone on a highway with a weapon and shooting within 150 feet of a residence. Her long criminal history includes causing property damage at her children's father's new girlfriend's home by throwing rocks through the window and trying to kick down the door. The father of her children, Egypt and Empress Love, is far from a prize. He is currently facing drug, habitual felon, and probation revocation charges in Guilford County. A second man with whom she had a relationship, and against whom Young obtained a protective order, has an equally long rap sheet.

Even without a nursing license, her Facebook profile indicates she is involved with a self-help, debt consolidation company based out of Atlanta that helps people take control. Set up like a mid-level marketing company, it appears that she gets additional funding for getting others to sign up. She also sells supplements and other goods online. After reading that a reddit poster relies on Young for her hair care, a search of North Carolina's Board of Cosmetic Examiners website provided matches to a former license as a Natural Hair Care Specialist that expired in October 2020. Young currently holds a license as a Natural Hair Care Teacher that will expire on October 1, 2022. We continue to have questions about her career, especially as a nurse, but Young has not completed a Statement of Economic Interest that verifies any of this information.

Our searches in Guilford County did not provide any matches to any property owned by Young, and she was not subject to any property tax information.

In early April 2022, Young established a campaign finance committee with the North Carolina State Board of Elections. Since that time, she reportedly raised just \$140, a personal contribution immediately spent. She also seems to not understand the campaign finance filing system and received letters about an early filing tied to the second quarter, which was just a duplicate of her original filing. In fact, the \$140 payment made to her committee was dated February 28, 2022, or the day before she claimed her organizing report opened.

Similarly, our searches did not find any contributions to federal candidates and committees or state candidates and committees, beyond the \$140 contribution.

## Biography

Young does not have a campaign website, nor does she have a candidate page on Facebook or any other social media platform. In lieu of this, we took any information we could obtain from news coverage to determine information about her background. A May 8, 2021 profile of Young and her primary opponent, Eddie Aday provided the most comprehensive information about her plans for District 59.

This time two Democrats, [Eddie Aday](#), a military veteran and farm owner from Gibsonville, and [Sherrie Young](#), a nurse from Greensboro, want to take on Hardister.

Aday and Young are both newcomers to politics who describe different motivations to enter the race, so to learn more about their campaigns and how the issues they see as primary, we submitted to them five questions via email.

Their responses, lightly edited, are presented here in alphabetical order.

Why did you decide to enter this race?

**SHERRIE YOUNG:** I've decided to join the race to make a difference in my community tremendously. Being a voice for the people is the most important structure in areas of environmental awareness, fair regulations and over taxation.

What do you see as the biggest issues facing North Carolina in the next four years?

**SHERRIE YOUNG:** The biggest issues I see North Carolina faces in the next 4 years are our natural resources. Clean drinking water needs to be re-enforced without harmful chemicals as well as purification from COVID-19 to ensure healthy citizens.

Gas prices and pollution from vehicles can be enhanced with proper alternatives by going green. Solar panels to reduce electric bills as well as placing more jobs to stay here vs. overseas are my main concern.

How has your personal experience/journey positioned you – uniquely or otherwise – to represent your district through this period?

**SHERRIE YOUNG:** Some personal experiences that have qualified me for this position are the places I hold on many committee boards in the community, such as: Chessmen Club, ex-offender rehabilitation, Face Figure for Domestic Violence and many more. Being a public figure for Joblink is one of my greatest accomplishments seeing how I've referenced thousands to upgrade their career paths to generate more revenue for our city.

What have been decisions made by the General Assembly leaders that you wish would get another review?

**SHERRIE YOUNG:** Some decisions I'd like to take for re-review are justice system policies and procedures.

What is your wish list for this district?

**SHERRIE YOUNG:** My wish list is to become elected to make a difference for District 59.

## **Professional License**

Young describes herself as a nurse in news coverage and in a Facebook [profile](#), and we attempted to verify this information. Currently, the North Carolina State Board of Nursing has no record of a Sherrie Young holding a license as a nurse in the State of North Carolina. Additionally, we found no one with a similar name holding any type of license in Greensboro or throughout the state.

Because of Guilford County's proximity to Virginia, we searched the Virginia DHP website and did not find any matches to licenses of any kind held by Young.

Our searches yielded a match to licenses held (and formerly held) in with the North Carolina Board of Cosmetic Art Examiners. Young was licensed as a Natural Hair Care Specialist on May 15, 2012 (Lic. # 343). Her active license expired on October 27, 2020. Currently, Young holds a Natural Hair Care Teacher License (Lic. #: 158) that was issued on February 10, 2014. It will expire on October 1, 2022.

**Voter Registration**

Young registered to vote in North Carolina on November 1, 2012 as a member of the Democratic Party (ID: 000010099918). Since that time, she participated in just three elections. Her first Democratic ballot pulled included one that lists her as a candidate.

# Legal and Financial Records

## Statement of Economic Interest

As of July 23, 2022, Young has not filed a Statement of Economic Interest with the North Carolina Ethics Commission.

## Property Records

Our searches did not yield matches to property owned by Young in North Carolina.

Young has an extensive legal record in North Carolina.

According to the case file, Young had a concealed Smith & Wesson .380 semi-automatic pistol in her purse at her feet with an open vodka bottle during a traffic stop. Prior to the dismissal, she completed a Mothers Against Drunk Driving Victim Impact Panel Program on June 14, 2015. She forfeited to weapon to authorities, per the direction of the judge.

According to the case file, a complaint by Knechia (Nnechia) Nicole Crews alleged that her boyfriend's ex-girlfriend and mother of his children, Sherrie Young, was throwing rocks at her home, shattering windows, and kicking her doors. When her boyfriend confronted Young, she took off in her vehicle, a Geo Tracker. Young was ordered to stay away from Crews.

### Campaign Finance

Young established a campaign finance committee, Sherrie Young for State House (ID: STA-7VL3DY-C-001), with the North Carolina State Board of Elections on April 4, 2022.

Young's sole \$140 contribution came from herself on February 28, 2022 (outside of the organizational reporting period she disclosed).

She has not made any filings since that time, although notice from the North Carolina State Board of Elections sent her a notice claiming she was filing too early for the second quarter. A review of the document they reference indicates that the filing is an additional copy of her organizational form.

### Election Results

#### *2022 Primary Election*

Somehow, Young received more than 74% of the vote in the May primary against a better funded and more articulate candidate, Eddie Aday.

### Contributions to Others

Young did not contribute to any federal candidates or committees, according to the Federal Elections Commission. A \$270 contribution to the North Carolina Republican Party via WinRed attributed to a Sherrie Young of Greensboro, NC, is actually 56-year-old Sherrie Thomas Young of 4514 Jessup Grove Road, Greensboro, NC.

#### *State Contributions*

In North Carolina, Young has not given to any state candidates or committees, besides the \$140 given to her own committee for State House.
