Summary of Findings

Diamond Staton-Williams is a 45-year-old Democratic Town Council Member in Harrisburg, NC. She and her husband, Chico, have two kids, and Staton-Williams brought a third to their marriage. The family resides in a modest home that was purchased as a new build fourteen years ago.

A registered nurse by trade, Staton-Williams is also active in local non-profits tied to the healthcare industry, specifically mental health. Her husband serves as the facilities director at a law firm in Charlotte. Staton-Williams's financial disclosures show that despite living a comfortable, middle-class lifestyle, the family has significant debt due to student loans, personal debt, and money owed to commercial banks and credit unions. Their adult children secured student loans to attend college while simultaneously working in local retail.

Rewinding in Staton-Williams's life just 15 years paints a very different story. As recently as 2005, she was successfully sued for non-payment of rent and evicted from a home in Mecklenburg County. Five years earlier, she was also evicted for non-payment of rent. She was the subject of more than 20 traffic and criminal citations, including a non-prosecuted misdemeanor for Simple Assault. As a minor, she was cited for providing false information to a police officer and for driving without a license. While many of her citations were issued for speeding, she was also ticketed on at least six occasions for expired registration. The pattern of not paying responsibilities tied to vehicles is reflected in delinquent personal property taxes for cars owned by them from 2008 to 2013, when Staton-Williams and her husband incurred hundreds of dollars in interest and fees for these payments.

As a candidate, Staton-Williams ran successfully for town council in Harrisburg in 2017 and 2021 by placing in the top three in seven-way races. The North Carolina State Board of Elections provided electronic access to just the 2021 financial information tied to her candidacy. This shows that she raised about \$16,000 in itemized contributions, including more than \$3,100 from the medical industry. From this committee, she transferred just more than \$1,200 to her campaign-finance committee to run for state house.

Staton-Williams gave thousands of dollars to candidates and committees during the past decade, showing dozens of small-dollar amounts given to a PAC tied to her job with Atrium Healthcare. In total, she gave about \$6,000 to federal and state candidates, of which \$2,700 was given to her own campaign committees.

On March 11, 2022, Staton-Williams established a campaign finance committee, Committee to Elect Diamond Staton-Williams (ID: STA-AR4PU0-C-001), with the North Carolina State Board of Elections. Immediately, the State Board of Elections notified her of errors in the form, and a modified State of Organization was accepted on March 18, 2022.

Previously, Staton-Williams submitted reports tied to her campaign for Harrisburg Town Council, Campaign to Elect Diamond Staton-Williams (ID: 207-AR4PU0-C-001) covering only the 2021 election.
